

**EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. 86-2014**

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING DONATIONS FROM VARIOUS DONORS TO BE USED FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FIRE, DEPARTMENT OF POLICE, K-9 OFFICER, AND POLICE HONOR GUARD, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council desires to recognize and accept the donations made to be used for the Department of Fire, Department of Police, K-9 Officer, and Police Honor Guard.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: The following donations are hereby accepted and to be used exclusively for the Department of Fire:

SECTION 4: The donation from Middletown Community Foundation in the amount of \$780.11 is hereby accepted and to be used exclusively for the Police Honor Guard.

SECTION 5: The donation from Garver Family Farm Market in the amount of \$200.00 is hereby accepted and to be used exclusively for the Mound tree removal.


