

**EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 2020-13**

AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 2020-12 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council adopted Emergency Ordinance No. 2020-12 on March 24, 2020 outlining procedures for remote meetings; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio General Assembly passed House Bill 197, a portion of which, amends the Ohio Open Meetings Law permitting public bodies to conduct meetings and hearings electronically during the State of Emergency in an Executive Order by Ohio Governor Mike DeWine; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to follow the guidelines set forth by the State of Ohio in Ohio Revised Code Section 121.221.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: Emergency Ordinance No. 2020-12 is hereby rescinded in its entirety.


