

EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 2021-44

AN ORDINANCE ADJUSTING THE COMPENSATION OF THE LAW DIRECTOR AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Section 8.04 of the Charter requires that the Law Director be the legal advisor, attorney and counsel for the Municipality, and for all offices, departments, divisions, bureaus, boards, commissions, and bodies of the Municipality in connection with Municipal affairs; and subject to the direction of the Council, shall represent the Municipality in all proceedings in court or before any administrative board or body; and

WHEREAS, Section 8.04 of the Charter further requires that the Law Director shall perform such other duties consistent with his office, as may be required by this Charter, by ordinance or resolution of the Council, or by the laws of the State of Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the Law Director's annual salary was last adjusted in 2008; and

WHEREAS, due to the growing needs of the City of Monroe, including legal matters, Council desires to adjust the compensation of the Law Director.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: The Law Director's annual salary shall be sixty nine thousand dollars (\$69,000.00) per year effective September 1, 2021.

SECTION 2: The Law Director shall receive a cost of living increase as approved by Council for nonunion employees on or after January 1, 2022.

SECTION 3: The Law Director shall be entitled to receive other insurance benefits offered to the employees of the City of Monroe and subject to the same conditions.

SECTION 4: On or before September 1 of each year the Law Director shall receive a performance evaluation as prepared by the Council.


SECTION 5: This measure is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and further for the reason that Council desires to lessen the impact on payroll for the effective date of the within salary adjustment. Therefore, this measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.
