

**EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. 49-2021**

A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO CAUSE THE SPEED LIMIT ON LEBANON STREET TO BE REDUCED FROM 35 MILES PER HOUR TO 25 MILES PER HOUR AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed and residents of Lebanon Street have appeared before City Council requesting a reduction in the speed limit from 35 miles per hour to 25 miles per hour; and

WHEREAS, Council deems it necessary to reduce the speed limit on Lebanon Street for the safety of the residents, pedestrians, and vehicular traffic on Lebanon Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: Pursuant to Section 406.07 of the Codified Ordinances, Council hereby directs the City Manager to cause the speed limit on Lebanon Street to be reduced from 35 miles per hour to 25 miles per hour.


SECTION 2: This measure is hereby declared to be an emergency necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and further for the reason that Council deems it in the best interest and safety of the citizens to reduce the speed limit at the earliest possible date. Therefore, this measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.
